

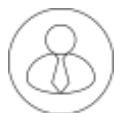

I.a) Purposes of the processing of your personal data:

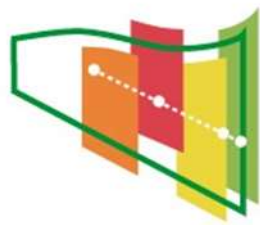

III) Storage periods observed in the processing of your personal data:

- **[1]**: coinciding with the precontractual activity period (so, up to the end of the definition of the agricultural products' importation service requested by you) / coinciding with the contractual activity period (so, up to the end of the development of the agricultural products' importation service defined with you);
- **[2]**: coinciding with the precontractual activity period (so, up to the end of the definition of the agricultural products' importation service requested by you) and - if need be - additional 10 years effective from the conclusion of the precontractual activity period (so, from the end of the definition of the agricultural products' importation service requested by you) / coinciding with the contractual activity period (so, up to the end of the development of the agricultural products' importation service defined with you) and - if need be - additional 10 years effective from the conclusion of the contractual activity period (so, from the end of the development of the agricultural products' importation service defined with you);
- **[3]**: 10 years effective from the conclusion of the precontractual activity period (so, from the end of the definition of the agricultural products' importation service requested by you) / 10 years effective from the conclusion of the contractual activity period (so, from the end of the development of the agricultural products' importation service defined with you).

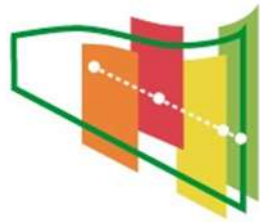
IV.a) Your rights enforceable acting as Data subject:

- ✓ access to your processed personal data, pursuant to art. 15 of the G.D.P.R.;
- ✓ rectification of your processed personal data, pursuant to art. 16 of the G.D.P.R.;
- ✓ erasure of your processed personal data, pursuant to art. 17 of the G.D.P.R., in case of:
 - your discovery of the successive absence of the Controller's need of processing your personal data for one or more purposes of the processing stated in "**Purposes of the processing of your personal data**";
 - your objection to the processing of your processed personal data processed - pursuant to art. 21, pa. 1 of the G.D.P.R. - for **[3]**, in absence of the Controller's concomitant lawful and prevalent need of carrying on such processing;
 - your discovery of the original or successive absence of the lawfulness of the processing of your processed personal data;
 - your discovery of the successive presence of the Controller's need of complying with legal obligations to which it is subject;
- ✓ restriction of the processing of your processed personal data, pursuant to art. 18 of the G.D.P.R., in case of:
 - your discovery of the original or successive absence of the accuracy of your processed personal data, during its verification made by the Controller;
 - your discovery of the original or successive absence of the lawfulness of the processing of your processed personal data, in presence of your following opposition to their erasure;
 - your discovery of the successive absence of the Controller's need of processing your personal data for one or more purposes of the processing stated in "**Purposes of the processing of your personal data**", in presence of your following additional discovery of the presence of your need of processing them for establishing, exercising or defending one of your rights in an extrajudicial or judicial phase;
 - your objection to the processing of your processed personal data processed - pursuant to art. 21, pa. 1 of the G.D.P.R. - for **[3]**, during the verification of the presence of the Controller's concomitant lawful and prevalent need of carrying on such processing;
- ✓ portability of your processed personal data, pursuant to art. 20 of the G.D.P.R., regarding:
 - your personal data processed for **[1]**, limited to the development of the agricultural products' importation service defined with you;
- ✓ objection to the processing of your processed personal data, pursuant to art. 21, pa. 1 of the G.D.P.R., regarding:
 - your personal data processed for **[3]**.

IV.b) Your right (enforceable acting as Data subject) to lodge a complaint with a Supervisory authority:
